Five Player Team Sets Monmouth County All-Time Score

John Hadjipetros of Point Pleasant led his F&H Drywall of Brick sponsored five-player team with his first 800 series on games of 248, 299 and 266 for a leading 813 series and a Monmouth County team high series of 3610. His leading 299 in the middle game also helped give the Monmouth County an all-time leading five-player high team game of 1318.

The rest of the record 1318 and 3610 scores were built on the next players in order: Brian Rosseter, Eatontown, 257, 216, 244 for a 717; Al Pfister, Point Pleasant, 167, 248, 208 for a 623; Team Captain Dave Campbell, Neptune, held both highs with games of 232, 277, 216 for a 720 set; and Anchorman Lou Colucci of Freehold with the needed scores to set both team high game and series with 255, 278, 204 for a 737.

The 1318 record game topped the previous high of 1285 shot last year at Memory Bowling put together by William Sims 269, Chris Straniero 219, Gary Eichenholtz 227, Rich Pfeffer 300 and John Santalucia 270.

The previous high series of 3547 was also set at Memory Bowling by Jason Cassano 604, Roger Gardner 793, Barry Marcus 723, John Paris 722 and Mike Reasoner 705.
