## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. The tournament is operated under the strict rules of TNBA / USBC, and is open to all bowlers who are members of The National Bowling Association and certified by TNBA, and USBC for the 2009-2010 season.
2. All entrants must use their highest USBC certified average for the 2008-2009 season of at least 21 games. If you do not have a 2008-2009 average, then use the highest current season USBC average of 21 games as of March 7, 2010. If you do not have an acceptable 2009-2010 average, you must bowl with an entry average of 230.
3. Female entrants who are members of non-merged state or local women's associations also qualify for awards from those associations.
4. Bowlers who cash must give the tournament manager average verification through their local bowling association(s) within three (3) weeks after the tournament or forfeit prize awards. Forfeited prize money is awarded to the next highest qualifying team or bowler.
5. This is a DOUBLES and SINGLES, any gender combination TOURNAMENT.
6. Failure to use correct USBC certified average disqualifies the team if the average submitted is lower than the actual average. Bowlers must use the average submitted on application. Change in average must be made before end of first line bowled. Score appeals must be submitted in writing within 24 hours after bowling.
7. HANDICAP: Handicap is based on 100% of the combined averages and 460 Scratch for Doubles and 230 for singles. COMBINED AVERAGES ABOVE 460 ARE DISQUALIFIED. **Doubles disqualifications are not automatic singles disqualifications.**  
**Bowlers are solely responsible for averages shown on applications. Bowlers must qualify for handicap to enter the singles handicap event.**
8. Captains report for check-in 30 minutes before squad time with all USBC certification cards.
9. Bowlers unable to present certification cards at registration must pay affiliate dues prior to bowling. **TNBA – \$15.00; USBC – \$18.00.** When local and state dues are not known, associate dues are \$21 (\$10 national, \$10 local, \$1 state, females only). (USBC Rule 300c (2a); TNBA Rule III).
10. USBC Rules 300b (1), (3), (4); 300c (2), 319a, 319c, 319d and 319e, eligibility and averages apply to all bowlers. USBA Rule 319a applies for bowlers with a current average 15 pins over 2008-2009 average.
11. Re-entries are permitted. Bowlers may cash once with the SAME PARTNER, but may cash with a change of partner. **A bowler can cash only once in the singles event (USBC Rule 315c).**
12. Should ties occur, the teams affected split the sum of the place monies assigned to the winning and the next lower places.
13. If the tournament is terminated for reasons beyond control of the Tournament Management, the prize fund is pro-rated according to the number of bowled entries up to the time of termination. Complete entry fees are refunded to all entrants, who cannot bowl due to termination of the tournament,
14. The tournament fee is \$40.00 per Team, \$20.00 for Singles. Bowling fee is \$9.00 per bowler, per event. Prize fee is \$9.00 per bowler, per event – 100% returned based on 1 in 8 entries. Expenses are \$2.00 per bowler, per event. **PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AFTER March 1, 2010; Cash or money order only.**
