MONMOUTH COUNTY USBC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Open to all Monmouth County USBC certified bowling grandmothers. All entrants must present a current USBC card.
2. Tournament will consist of one Doubles Event (9:00 am) followed by one Singles Event (11:00 am).
3. Check in time is 45 minutes before squad time.
4. **AVERAGE:** Entrants must use their highest USBC Monmouth County average for 2008-2009 winter season based on 21 games or more. Entrants without a 2008-2009 winter average will use their current highest USBC Monmouth County average as of January 22, 2010 based on 12 or more games (**below section must be completed by your league secretary**). Entrants without a current 12 games USBC Monmouth County average will use 200 scratch average. Ten pin drop rules does not apply (USBC Rule 319A-2). USBC Rule 319E is waived. Handicap is 100% of the difference of entrant's average and 230.
5. It is the entrants' responsibility to verify the accuracy of her average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify any score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Correction of average can be made up to the completion of the first game of the series. An extension of time (48 hours) to correct the average can be given to the bowler providing such extension has been requested prior to the completion of the first game of the series. Such extension of time shall only be given by the Tournament Director. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
6. No blind score shall be permitted. Late bowlers will receive zero for each frame missed. Late bowler may enter game at frame currently in progress.
7. Substitutes will be allowed providing the Tournament Manager is notified at least one hour before the scheduled time of bowling. Substitutes must meet all requirements of Rule 1 and 4. At tournament time please have the substitute's name, address, USBC Number, and Secretary's verification of average. Substitutes will be permitted in case of disability after the game has started in the Doubles Event only (USBC Rule 324B).
8. All protests affecting eligibility or general playing rules are to be filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Scoring errors must be confirmed in writing 24 hours after the series bowled. All decisions of the Tournament Committee will be considered final unless an appeal is made under USBC Rule 329.
9. In case of a tie for first place only, Co-Champions will be declared. Prize monies will be combined and divided equally for all other ties.
10. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date of **29 January 2010** for any cancellations. Entry fee breakdown is \$10.00 Prize Fund, \$9.00 Lineage, \$1.00 Youth Scholarship Fund and \$3.00 for expenses per bowler.
11. USBC Rule 319C (average adjustment) and USBC Rule 319D (report prior winnings) shall be waived.
