

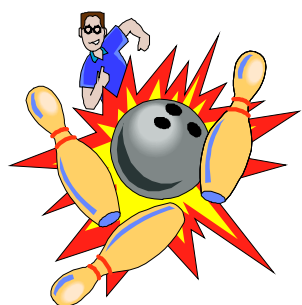

1 - This is a Monmouth County USBC certified handicap singles bowling tournament. Open to all Youth bowlers who have NOT reached the age of 20 as of August 1st, 2011. Check-in begins at 11:30 am and tournament play starts at 12:30 pm. Every bowler MUST present their 2011 - 2012 season USBC membership card.

2 - Handicap will be figured based on the following book average in this order

A - Highest 2010 – 2011 book average, minimum 21 games - OR

B - Highest 2011 - Summer book average, minimum 21 games - OR

C - Highest 2011 – 2012 current season average, minimum 21 games by March 13, 2012

3 - DIVISIONS: The Youth Bowler's AVERAGE will determine what division they will bowl.

4 - DRESS CODE: ALL bowlers MUST wear a COLLARD shirt or the USBC bowling youth shirt. No hats may be worn during tournament. NO ripped jeans, NO shirts with abscent words/phrases allowed. This WILL BE STRICKLY ENFORCED

5 - FORMAT: The format is the same for all divisions. Youth Bowlers will bowl (3) games on the same pair of lanes. Scratch score plus handicap, will determine the finishing place for both Male and Female bowler. Handicap will be 100% difference of bowler's average and 200. All bowlers with an average of 200 or over will receive 0 handicap

6 - AWARDS: The Winner of each division, based on no fewer than 3 Male and 3 Females in each division, will be awarded a SMART scholarship as indicated. If less than 3 entries in any division, Smart Scholarship payout would be adjusted. 100% of all collected scholarship funds for youth bowlers will be awarded and sent to the SMART Program for management and dispersal. Information about the SMART Program is available on www.bowl.com All division 1st Place Male and Female winners will receive a trophy in addition to Scholarship money. Final results of tournament will be on posted Monmouth County Bowling website www.monmouthcountybowling.com

7 - COACHING during competition is NOT permitted. Bowler(s) may be disqualified if coaching is going on at the time of competition (USBC rule 303).

8 - All USBC Youth Tournament rules will be observed and the decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
