RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. THIS TOURNAMENT IS AN OFFICIAL FUNCTION OF MC USBC BA AND JOINTLY CONDUCTED BY THE MC USBC BA AND THE MC USBC WBA .
  2. ELIGIBILITY: PARTICIPATION IS OPEN TO ALL MONMOUTH COUNTY SANCTIONED BOWLERS CURRENTLY BOWLING IN SANCTIONED LEAGUES IN MONMOUTH COUNTY. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE SANCTIONED BY USBC.
  3. HANDICAP: HANDICAP IS BASED ON 100% OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TEAMS HIGHEST ENTERING AVERAGE AND ON A SCRATCH FIGURE OF 460 PER TEAM.
  4. ENTERING AVERAGE: ALL BOWLERS WILL USE THEIR HIGHEST SANCTIONED USBC AVERAGE FOR 21 GAMES OR MORE IN THE FOLLOWING SEQUENCE:
    - (A) WINTER OR SUMMER SEASON 2006-2007
    - (B) WINTER SEASON 2005-2006
    - (C) CURRENT SEASON - EFFECTIVE DATE FOR USING CURRENT SEASON AVERAGE IS OCT. 31, 2007RULE 319A - IF CURRENT SEASON AVERAGE IS THE ONLY AVERAGE AVAILABLE IT IS THE BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO PROVIDE WRITTEN PROOF OF AVERAGE AT THE TIME OF SCHEDULED BOWLING. ALL OTHERS BOWL SCRATCH (BOWLERS CURRENTLY IN USBC YOUTH SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM THE TOURNAMENT). USBC RULE 319A2 TEN PIN INCREASE PROVISION WILL NOT APPLY FOR THIS TOURNAMENT. RULE 319D AND 319E WILL ALSO NOT APPLY.
  5. QUALIFYING AVERAGE: IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF HIS OR HER AVERAGE LISTED ON THIS ENTRY WHETHER SUBMITTED BY THE BOWLER, PARTNER OR ANY OTHER REPRESENTATIVE. FAILURE TO USE PROPER AVERAGE OR MAKE A CORRECTION UP TO COMPLETION OF THE FIRST GAME OF A SERIES SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE. IF SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN ACTUAL AVERAGE, PRIZE WINNINGS WILL BE BASED ON SUBMITTED AVERAGE. IF IT IS HIGHER, RULE 319E APPLIES.
  6. MULTIPLE ENTRY: EACH TEAM SHALL CONSIST OF 1 MAN AND 1 WOMAN. AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BOWL UNLIMITED TIMES AS LONG AS EACH TIME IT IS WITH A DIFFERENT PARTNER. IF BOWLING MORE THAN ONCE, PLEASE NOTE IF SECOND OR THIRD ENTRY.
  7. RERATING. USBC RULE 319C ALLOWS TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT THE OPPORTUNITY TO ADJUST A BOWLERS AVERAGE UPWARD PRIOR TO THE BOWLER'S PARTICIPATION IN ANY EVENT.
1. THREE GAMES ON A PAIR OF LANES, TOTAL PINS SCRATCH, AND WITH HANDICAP INCLUDED, WILL DETERMINE FINAL POSITION STANDINGS.
  2. TEAM MAY WIN A PRIZE IN BOTH DIVISIONS. NO PREVIOUS TOURNAMENT PRIZE WINNINGS NEED TO BE REPORTED.
  3. A MAXIMUM OF FOUR TEAMS WILL BE SCHEDULED TO A PAIR OF LANES.
  4. EACH PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO PRACTICE DELIVERIES ON EACH LANE.
  5. HANDICAP PRIZE LIST AND SCRATCH PRIZES WILL BE POSTED AT TOURNAMENT SITE AT THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT. AT LEAST ONE PRIZE FOR EVERY TEN ENTRIES.
  6. BOWLERS ARRIVING LATE WILL BOWL IN THE SAME FRAME AS THE TEAM IS BOWLING. NO SCORING FOR UNBOWLED FRAMES.
  7. GROUPS WANTING TO BE SCHEDULED TOGETHER MAY MAKE PARTY RESERVATIONS WHILE THE SPACES REMAIN AVAILABLE, PRIOR TO OCT. 31, 2007
  8. ANY PROTEST EFFECTING ELIGIBILITY OR GENERAL PLAYING RULES MUST BE CONFIRMED IN WRITING TO A RESPONSIBLE TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH USBC RULE 329
  9. ALL DECISIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE SHALL BE FINAL UNLESS AN APPEAL IS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH USBC RULE 329.
  10. ANY PROTEST INVOLVING SCORING ERRORS MUST BE MADE WITHIN 48 HOURS.
  11. NO REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE MADE.
  12. FIRST PLACE TIES WILL BE ROLLED OFF WITHIN 10 DAYS. THREE GAMES SHALL BE PLAYED IN DECIDING A TIE. TOURNAMENT RULES STILL APPLY. WHEN TIES OCCUR OTHER THAN FOR FIRST PLACE, THE PRIZE MONEY WILL BE COMBINED AND DIVIDED EQUALLY AMONG THE TIED POSITION WINNERS.
  13. THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESCHEDULE ENTRIES TO AN ALTERNATE SQUAD IF THERE ARE INSUFFICIENT ENTRIES IN A PARTICULAR SQUAD TIME.
  14. PRACTICE BOWLING WILL BE PERMITTED UNTIL 1 1/2 HOURS PRIOR TO SQUADS STARTING.
  15. CONDUCT: ANY INDIVIDUAL THAT IS CHARGED BY THIS TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WITH MISCONDUCT, AS DESCRIBED IN USBC RULE 17B, DURING PLAY IN THIS TOURNAMENT MAY BE PENALIZED BY ANY OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
    1. LOSS OF PRIZE WINNINGS IN THIS EVENT.
    2. SUSPENSION FROM PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT.
    3. DENIAL OF FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT.MISCONDUCT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:  
OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE, DISTRACTING OR LOUD BEHAVIOR AND/OR BEHAVIOR THAT PUTS ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN A POSITION OF PHYSICAL HARM.
