RULES and REGULATIONS

1. To be eligible, all bowlers must be sanctioned with Monmouth County USBC by February 20th, 2010, which is 30 days prior to the start of the tournament. Bowlers under 18 years of age who are high school students must have written parental or guardian consent. Inter-county bowlers not sanctioned through Monmouth County are not eligible. Substitutes will be permitted. Pacers will not be permitted.
2. All entries must be submitted on an Official Entry Blank. Bowlers will compete in the order as submitted on the form. Captains must sign where indicated. Bowlers must report 30 minutes prior to their scheduled start time
3. Entries will be scheduled in the order received. The Tournament Manager will assign lanes.
4. Team captain is responsible for submitting correct information. If an illegal entry should be accepted through error, all fees paid will be forfeited and scores rolled will be null and void. Any protest affecting eligibility, or general playing rules, must be confirmed in writing to a Tournament Official. Errors must be reported to the Tournament Manager within 24 hours.
5. The Tournament will be handicap event based on 100% of the difference between highest season average and basic scratch figure. Basic scratch figure shall be: 920 in Teams; 460 in Doubles; and 230 for Singles.
6. Team event will consist of four members: multiple entries are permitted in Team event. However, when three or more members of a four bowler team already entered in the tournament bowl together on another four bowler team, they can place only once in the prize list for gross and/or net position standings. First team event bowled will count toward All Event total. Only one entry is permitted in Singles and Doubles event. Singles and Doubles will bowl together and both bowlers must enter both events. The single event will bowl first.
7. Average will be used in the following order:
 - a. Highest 2008-2009 Winter or 2009 Summer season for 21 games or more;
 - b. If a bowlers' average based on a minimum of 21 games as of March 1, 2010 is fifteen pins higher than their 2008-2009 average, this average must be used;
 - c. If no 2008-2009 average, Highest average as of March 1st 2010 for 21 games or more
 - d. No average will use 230 scratch
8. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in this tournament, whether originally submitted by the bowler, her team captain, or others. If submitted average is higher than the established average, prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average. If the average submitted is lower than highest book average, bowler will be disqualified and all monies won will be forfeited.
9. Ties: In case of a tie for 1st place in any event, teams or individuals shall be declared "Co-Champions. 1st and 2nd place monies, as well as other tied positions, shall be equally divided.
10. Bowlers arriving late will start to bowl in the same frame as the team is bowling. No scoring for unbowed frames – USBC Rule #322A shall prevail
11. Check made payable to **MC USBC Women's Tourney** or money order must accompany each application and mailed to the Tournament Manager. Entry fee to be \$22 per event (\$10 for prize money, \$9 for bowling, \$2 for expenses, and \$1 Youth Fund).
12. All Events is on a scratch basis and entry is optional with the bowler. Entry fee for All Events is \$2. All Event is the total of your Team, Doubles, and Singles scores. All Events fee will be returned 100% in prize money. The bowler who bowls the highest All Events shall receive the All Events trophy, whether or not she paid the optional All Events fee. Prize money shall be awarded only to those who paid the fee.
13. **PREMATURE TERMINATION OF TOURNAMENT:** Brought about by war, terrorism, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond control of MCBA shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.
14. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
15. Entries close midnight March 13th 2010. Absolutely no applications will be accepted after that date. Telephone entries will not be permitted.
